The awards open for nominations include:

Clay Adamson Facilities Services Employee of the Year Award

The Clay Adamson Facilities Service Employee of the Year Award is a prestigious award which recognizes meritorious job performance during the last year by the Facilities Services Division for Augusta University employees.

James A. & Erie P. Blissit Award

The James A. & Erie P. Blissit Award honors active, full-time, classified Augusta University employees with at least one year of continuous employment who perform administrative, clerical, and secretarial support.

Golden Pen Award

The Golden Pen Award recognizes staff that have reached a significant level of achievement and excellence both in their career and in their contributions to the growth and development of Augusta University or AU Health by either publishing or presenting outside of the Augusta University or AU Health organization.

Hospital Quality Award

AU Health, and the Medical Center in particular, recognizes and rewards employees who participate or lead performance improvement projects that improve hospital wide safety and quality. The Hospital Quality Award recognizes individuals who make significant contributions to promote a "culture of quality".

Service Excellence Award

The Service Excellence Award recognizes outstanding & high (or exemplary) quality performance towards the overall mission of all academic, administration, and clinical areas at Augusta University or AU Health.

SPIRIT Award Information

The SPIRIT Award recognizes individuals who embody the values of Augusta University or AU Health. It honors someone who consistently sets the ethical bar high in managing state resources, in their daily decision making and in the delivery of their work.

Teamwork Award
